It allows the user to look up words to find their meanings and associations with other words and concepts. The user can produce word diagrams to see how words associate.</p> <p>This is an interactive thesaurus and word tool to generate multiple meanings, synonyms and opposites of words.</p> <p>This tool uses photographs of words in the real world to help you visually explore them.</p> <p>RhymeZone is a simple website that will generate a list of rhyming words, sorted by number of syllables, for any word. Users may also look up definitions, synonyms, and more.</p>
